Newspapers, magazines,
or junk mail
Glue stick
Scissors
Construction paper



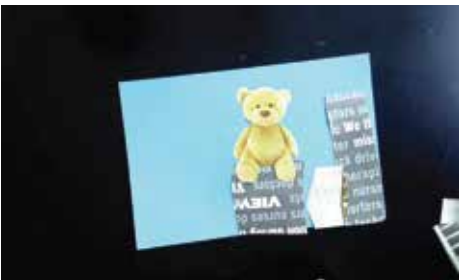
1. Use scissors to cut shapes out of magazines and newspapers that look like buildings of all shapes and sizes.



2. Look through your printed materials for an interesting picture you could use as a focal point for your city.



3. Lay out all your images and start planning your city.



4. Start arranging your images on your construction paper.



5. When you are happy with your arrangement, glue your shapes down.



6. Hang your artwork somewhere that everyone in your home can see it!
