I am going to the museum!



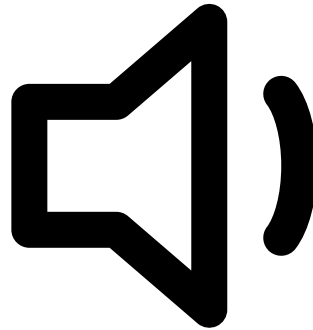
I will be greeted by friendly staff when I walk inside. I can ask for a sensory bag to borrow at the front desk. I will return the bag when I am leaving the museum.
