## **Community Foundation Grant**

Flint, MI – The Flint Institute of Arts (FIA) has received a \$3,500 grant from the Mary Elizabeth Adams Manley Beautification Fund of the Community Foundation of Greater Flint (CFGF). The grant will fund the exhibition *Vanessa German: Miracles and Glory Abound* and the accompanying catalog. The exhibition will open to the public on January 27, 2019, and will be on view through April 21, 2019.

Vanessa German is a multi-disciplinary artist based in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. She is the founder of Love Front Porch and ARThouse, a community arts initiative. She will be featured during the FIA's Community Gala on January 26, 2019, previewing her exhibition and discussing her work.
